Sally Gunning Book Reading & Signing

BREWSTER- The Brewster Ladies' Library welcomes Brewster resident and author, Sally Gunning for a reading from her new book, *Bound*, on Thursday, May 22 at 7:00 p.m. A question and answer session and book signing will follow the reading.

In this follow up to her acclaimed novel, *The Widow's War* Gunning returns to the same fertile ground and historically rich setting of pre-Revolutionary War Massachusetts.

Bound tells the story of Alice Cole, a girl, who at the age of seven, is sold into indentured service by her father, and barely remembers a time when she wasn't "bound." After spending her early years working in the home of compassionate John Morton and his family, at the age of fifteen, Alice's services are given to Morton's just-married daughter, Nabby. But the new situation quickly proves treacherous for Alice as she finds herself fearing for her life. She escapes to Boston and from there to Cape Cod, where, using an alias, she finds shelter, employment and friendship. Alice's peace is short-lived; try as she might to forge a new life for herself, Alice is a fugitive – and before long, the past she is running from catches up to her -- and threatens to destroy her.
